## GENERAL INFORMATION AND CAMPING RULES

### Show opening times

Kit Cars can arrive at the show at the Exhibitors and Kit Car Entrance (Green Gate) any time after 7.00am on Saturday and Sunday. The show opens to the public on Saturday at 10.00am until 5.00pm and again on Sunday at 9.30am until 4.30pm. You are requested to keep away from the exhibition buildings, during the hours when the show is not open to the public.

### Information Office

The Information office is located inside the George Stephenson main exhibition hall. This office is open until 9.00pm on Friday and during the show opening times on Saturday and Sunday. If you need assistance at other times, the security staff at the exhibitors gate can help.

### Medical and First Aid.

The St John Ambulance will be in attendance on the showground at the St John pavilion, during the hours of the show. The nearest casualty department is Newark General Hospital, Boundary Road. Newark. Tel: 01636 681681.

### Parking

Members of the public are informed that they use the car parks at their own risk. The organisers can not accept any responsibility for any damage or theft to or from a vehicle.

### Disabled Parking

An area has been reserved as Disabled Parking adjacent to the Public Entrance. Please ask parking steward to direct you to it.

### Road Traffic Act

Visitors, club members and individuals exhibiting their vehicles should be aware that the Road Traffic Act is in force on all parts of the showground. Please drive with care there are many young children around. Do not drive around the showground unnecessarily. There is a 10mph maximum speed limit on the showground. Do not drink and drive or take illegal substances, you can be prosecuted for doing so whilst on the showground. Everyone driving a mechanically propelled vehicle on the showground must be insured and hold a current driving licence. Our public liability insurance does NOT cover you for any kind of impact. Mini motor bikes and monkey bikes etc., are prohibited on the showground.

### Cash Point

There is no cash point on the showground. The nearest cash point is at the second roundabout on the way into Newark town centre, at McDonalds.

### Safety Information

Parents should keep their children under control, road traffic can be dangerous.  
Dogs should be kept on a lead at all times and clean up any mess they may create..  
All buildings are no smoking areas.

### Camping Ground rules

To ensure that we are all happy campers, it is necessary to state the ground rules. You camp at your own risk. Do not leave valuables unattended. The organisers can not accept any liability for loss or damage to your possessions. Camping is only available on the designated areas within the showground site, on Friday and Saturday nights only. All campers are requested to vacate the site on Sunday. All campers must be in possession of a valid ticket for BOTH days of the show. Do not pitch your tent/caravan too close to others, you should maintain an adequate fire break. There is sufficient space for all. Open fires are not allowed due to the fire risk. Please exercise extreme care with barbecues and **do not** dispose of hot embers into the refuse bins. Many families are camping on-site, so please keep noise levels down, particularly late at night. The organisers security staff are on-site and will remove those who fail to comply with these conditions. Please leave the site as you would wish to find it.

### Toilets and showers

Toilets are available on the camp site near to the stable block. Inside of the Joe Hallam Pavilion and next to the Public Entrance, you will find male and female showers and additional toilets (see plan of the showground). Elsan Points are located near the toilets at Red Gate (Public Entrance) and at Blue Gate (near the toilets outside the back of the George Stephenson Hall).

### Availability and charges

Camping is provided free of charge. You will have been charged admission for both days of the show, where necessary. Those who are only camping on Friday night, will have their money tendered for the Sunday refunded, when they leave the showground on the Saturday. This also applies if you are staying over Saturday night, but not staying for the show on Sunday, **you must** vacate the showground before 9.30am, when the show opens. If you fail to comply then the entrance money for the second day **will not** be refunded. To gain a refund of the Sunday entrance fee, you will need to surrender a valid Camping Pass. Produce it to the staff at the kit car and camping entrance on your way out, so don't lose your ticket.

### Access to the camp site

The vehicle entrance will be staffed 24 hours a day. If you leave the showground at any time, you must produce a valid ticket to gain re-entry. There will be security staff on duty at all times.
